Minor REVISION comments	(1) From the medical perspective, safety consciousness is important, which was emphasized in the 'Touch' section, but not mentioned in the 'Sound' section, especially in protection measures from honeybees and bumblebees. (2) Dementia is the first keywords. But there was little content reviewed on dementia in the article, while the section of 'scenario in Indian' does not interpret the effect of sensory garden on dementia. I suggest modifying the keywords.	Noted Okay
Optional/General comments	(1) The name of Table 3 was 'List of plants for attracting avians'. But the 'Attracting'part actually contains birds as well as bees and cricket. The names should to be changed.
