<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	In Section 5, the authors use a graph to detect the constant error variance (no heteroscedasticity) for the multiple linear regression model on the price of an automobile data. It is recommended to detect it also using the Breusch-Pagan test. In addition, the authors need to detect the independence between errors (no autocorrelation) using the Durbin-Watson test. The Breusch-Pagan and Durbin-Watson tests can be carried out through the <i>lmtest</i> package in R software with the <i>bptest()</i> and <i>dwttest()</i> functions. These two tests were performed for the complete and imputed datasets, respectively.
