However, the author needs to review literature from other jurisdictions (more countries/regions)</p> <p>SECTION 2-LIT REVIEW, the author goes into description of sub-sections 2.1-2.10 without a proper contextualization or introduction.... This leaves the whole section hanging and this not properly integrated in the article! -ALSO, check on the spelling issues e.g Section 3... is it methods/methodology???</p> <p>-The author does not specifically provide the data period....i.e was the financial statement for one year? 2 years? Etc. Equally give the source of the financial statements for verifiability if needed. Provide the financial years of the statements used i.e 20/21, 22/23 etc...</p>	<p>Yes, I have added an explanation of the variables in the title.</p> <p>An explanation of macroeconomic variables has been added to the introduction.</p> <p>The literature from other jurisdictions has been added.</p> <p>An introduction to the literature review has been added.</p> <p>It is a methods, and I have corrected it.
