Yes. Prevention of paediatric HIV infection is paramount in the reduction of prevalence rates.</li><li>2. Title could be made shorter. For instance "Evaluation of patients' adherence to Human Immunodeficiency Virus at the Ouagadougou University Teaching Hospital"</li><li>3. Need to mention what tests were used to determine factors influencing uptake in the abstract. The abstract should contain enough information as a standalone section. Aim for 3 to 5 keywords.</li><li>4. The subsections are incomplete. Need to see recommendations to authors on preparing manuscripts.</li><li>5. The methods are scientifically acceptable. Author has to present the ethical considerations. Was the study approved by an ethical committee?</li><li>6. References are recent but quite few. Need an extensive literature review in the discussion section. The author has limited his discussion to few references. Author should state what approach their country uses to screen pregnant women for HIV (opt in or opt out, etc.) Need to inform the audience the generalizability of the study results by doing an extensive literature review and explaining any possible differences seen.</li></ol> Author needs to mention any competing interest or declare if there is none.
