However, we have replaced the word 'Influence' with 'Evaluation' and also highlighted in the manuscript. Yes, the abstract is brief and have clarity.</p> <p>Thank you for pointing out. However, the manuscript has been presented in brief with no further classification for sections.</p> <p>The present sampling area belongs to Chakdaha and Kalyani block covering several villages under Nadia district of West Bengal which falls under Lower Gangetic Plains area as categorized by ICAR. The sample was obtained on random basis visiting the farmer's door to door on weekly basis for collection of required data. Similarly, after the data collection, to compare we have used chi-square test to find out the differences.</p> <p>Thank you for your valuable response</p>
