This is not a multifocal lesion2. There is neither synchronous nor asynchronous osteosarcoma. As this patient never had a history of osteosarcoma before and the site of osteosarcoma only over the mandible region. There is no other site of osteosarcoma at the moment.3. The staging of this patient is Stage III according to Enneking system4. Noted. The patient was subsequently referred to the oncology team for further radiotherapy due to a close tumor margin (1mm). She sustained left facial nerve palsy post-operation. Otherwise, her wound healed well, and no new swellings were observed during her follow-up 3 months later.5. Patient was treated with neoadjuvant chemotherapy but patient unable to complete the treatment regime, she only managed to complete for 2 cycles and then withhold in view of unable to tolerate the side effect of chemotherapy (lethargy, dizziness and poor oral intake)6. Unfortunately, patient was not undergone any genetic analysis before.7. The lesion is not associated with Rothmund – Thomson syndrome as patient was previously no known medical illness and didn't present with syndromic features
