The focus and discussion of the article are based on situs inversus, an anatomical variant that may not have greater relevance than the position of the organs; however, the description of the case reveals characteristics of levoisomerism (such as interruption of the vena cava and the position of the aorta), so I suggest that you base your discussion on levoisomerism and not only on situs inversus.	The article primarily highlights the rare association of multiple anomalies , the discussion is mainly about the rare association of both type 3b and type 4 intestinal atresia in a patient of situs inversus. Management is challenging in such cases and our focus is to make readers aware of such association and how to mange intra operatively as diagnosis is not possible pre op.
