Nonetheless, it is perhaps a little too lenient for an abstract; therefore, tighten the language to be more concise. For instance, "it can be concluded that concerning the level of the work organization and effectiveness" can be better worded as "Al significantly enhances E-Commerce  You have given the Quantitative Data of a mean rating of 4.4 and correlation of 0.75. It would sometimes be helpful to briefly explain what ratings of this nature represent in the context of your study.   |  |
| Are subsections and structure of the manuscript appropriate?  | The subsections and overall manuscript structure are good. Information is easily broken up into well-defined sections, such as Abstract, Introduction, Methodology, Results, Discussion, and Conclusion. Such an arrangement would help sections handle parts of the research suitably, which would be helpful for readers in pursuing the objectives of the study, its methods of inquiry, findings, and implications. Incorporating tables and thematic analysis also enriches the results in terms of presentation, so the data becomes more available. It makes the writing clear and clarifies the structure, hence important in good scientific communication.  |  |

If you have suggestions of additional references, please mention them in the review form. | The references given in the manuscript are satisfactory and relatively recent and tend to tackle the issues regarding all aspects of artificial intelligence in e-commerce, such as critical studies on issues related to operational efficiency, customer engagement, and the relative difficulties of Al implementation that are inherent major concerns to the focus of research.  However, to strengthen the manuscript, it might be helpful to incorporate even more recent articles or reviews specifically focusing on emerging trends in the Al technology itself, like progressive developments in machine learning algorithms, new insights into ethics in the context of Al applications, and case studies of different e-commerce sectors. Including references related to consumer behavior and concerns over privacy in greater detail might give a more detailed view of the current landscape.  Overall, even though the references look relevant to the manuscript and give it a richer authenticity, new views in this section of the literature review would give much insight to Al in e-commerce. |  |

The writing is clear, and the compound ideas and findings have been well stated. The manuscript makes appropriate use of academic terminology and maintains a formal tone overall.  However, in certain places, the wording could be sharpened regarding clarity or precision. Some parts may contain minor grammatical errors and some unpleasant wordings that need a bit more proofreading work. The language, in general, would be well within the standards of scholarly publishing in the majority of places with slight revision   |  |
| Optional/General comments   | The manuscript quite elaborately covers how artificial intelligence influences e-commerce, including the pros and cons of its adoption. Since research uses a combination of both quantitative and qualitative analysis, it is very rich, particularly in understanding operational efficiency and engagement. Further, more sweeping coverage of the paper on ethical implications and the wider context of Al in e-commerce would be required. Some sections need to be clarified, and minor language-related errors should be corrected to enhance the readability of this paper as a whole. The contribution of the study is very much appreciated, given the depth it brings to the topic, providing a solid foundation for further research.  This falls under the category of "Minor Revision," which means there are strengths in the manuscript with valid findings, but for clarity, structure, as well as possibly some challenges pointed out in the review, aspects for improvement are required.   |  |
