The Authors did not answered to the comments of reviewer 2 and did not include the reviewer's suggestions in revised version of the manuscript. That is why in my opinion the paper should not be published in Journal of Advances in Microbiology.

Though the journal's peer review policy states that NO manuscript should be rejected only on the basis of 'lack of Novelty', provided the manuscript is scientifically robust and technically sound, but this statement in my understanding of the sence of scientific publications regards only original papers and not review papers.

Maybe in this situatuion the final editorial decision should be done by other Editor.
