Optional/General comments	The manuscript can add new evidence to existing data on the study plant. However, it contains wrong interpretations and point of discussion. (1) Especially, the brine shrimp test is interpreted to imply anticancer activity; instead, it should be re-discussed in relation to safety concerns. (2) the study is aimed to compare a medicinal plant growing in three different place; but the discussion focused on verification, which has already been done by previous studies. Thus, it should be revised in accordance to the aim of the study. (2) the phytochemical studies are preliminary; hence, related descriptions and inferences should be within scope
