Yes, the title is suitable.</p> <p>3. The abstract is comprehensive but it's too long for an abstract as it exceeds 300 word, also some of the results are not clear and confusing</p> <p>4. The subsections and overall structure of the manuscript are appropriate, with an overall view about the disease and mention of the prevalence statistics of mortality and morbidity rates, the investigations and lines of treatment of diabetes, the objectives of the study was clear, as well as methodology of how the study was done with statistical analysis, but the results were not clear, misleading confusing and lead to misunderstanding, it is advisable to make it more clear, concerning discussion, the comparison with other studies was apparent but with no citation in the text to the references, or may be mentioned in the references but not cited in the text</p> <p>5. Scientific Correctness: the manuscript is scientifically corrected</p> <p>6. Sufficiency and Recent References: The references are sufficient but appear to be not recent as most of them are not updated, it's advisable to ensure that the most up-to-date literature is included</p> <p>7.
