Is the manuscript important for scientific community? (Please write few sentences on this manuscript)	Nano-urea has been shown to have positive effects on the growth and yield of wheat. In a study conducted by Mahipal Singh Choudhary et al., the application of nano-urea at 25-30 DAS and 45-50 DAS significantly increased plant height of wheat at 75 DAS. The tallest plant of wheat at harvest was observed under foliar application of nano-urea at 25-30 DAS and 45-50 DAS during both the years and on pooled data basis. Another study by Aakash Ojha et al. found that applying 100% nitrogen along with foliar spray of 4ml/L nano-urea significantly affected wheat growth, yield, and yield parameters. Furthermore, a study by Sharma et al. synthesized a nanocomposite of urea and chitosan as a slow-release fertilizer, which showed enhanced plant growth. These studies suggest that the application of nano-urea can lead to improved growth, yield, and nutritional quality of wheat. However, more comprehensive research is needed to fully understand the mechanisms behind the enhanced performance of wheat when treated with nano-urea.
