We recommend writing it in a more structured manner, starting with the problem (including objectives), followed by methods, results, and conclusions.</p> <p>We appreciate that the manuscript's structure is adequate. For further refinement, we offer the following suggestions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Data on the research problem (psychological well-being or mental health) is necessary to highlight the importance of conducting the study.2. The introduction should be organized into three or four paragraphs.3. Generally, the objectives are part of the introduction and not a separate section.4. The author can explain the research design used.5. The author can elaborate on the sample criteria.6. It is advisable for the author not to repeat the objectives in the Materials and Methods section, as they have been mentioned earlier.7. I suggest simplifying Table 4.2 by presenting data in categorical form (frequency and proportion for gender, education, and diseases) and central values (mean and standard deviation for age and psychological well-being).8. In the discussion section, we recommend integrating results. We suggest adding a review of previous studies and the author's opinions, especially incorporating recent findings from other researchers. <p>This writing is scientifically accurate.</p> <p>It is necessary to choose a single reference format for consistency in citation, whether alphabetical or numerical order. The UN and WHO are cited in the introduction but are not listed in the bibliography. Anonymous is not found in the citation sentences. There are 12 references older than ten years. Therefore, we recommend the author to add references from the last ten years to enhance the current relevance of the manuscript.</p>
