Other theoretical information regarding convenient sampling is not required Sample size calculation has not been mentioned The data was collected using a questionnaire – was the questionnaire validated? Data collection was using self assessment of skills on a lickert scale . This may not be an ideal tool for data collection for assessment of skill as the responses may be biased.
