The title of the article is suitable. 3. The abstract is comprehensive. 4. I suggest stating only the inclusion criteria. 5. The article is commentary in nature, hence not precisely scientific. But it tells us that healthcare professionals are human beings too and need help just like everyone else. 6. References should be 75% recent (5 years back).  Additional comment: This study reported that 8.2% of the suicide cases experienced of bullying/feeling bullied. The author further stated that certain groups may suffer bullying and discrimination more frequently than others. It made me think that the 8.2% suicide victims were not of English origin; they belonged to other nationalities. Hence, culture is a factor that could be further investigated.
