The title is not suitable – alternative title - ANTI-UROLITHIASIS ACTIVITY OF SELECTED PLANT EXTRACTS BY TITRIMETRY METHOD AND AGGREGATION ASSAY</p> <p>3. Abstract not comprehensive, does not include the result, brief discussion and conclusion at all.</p> <p>4. The subsections and structure is alright but major work needs to be done on the result and discussion section, all diagrams in the manuscript also should be relevant to the work and should be referred to in the manuscript.</p> <p>5. I think it is scientifically correct, however the tables in result and discussion contain absorbances, these can be converted to concentration as appropriate</p> <p>6. The references can be more robust.
