Clarity in Data Presentation: The manuscript provides valuable insights into avifaunal diversity in the Nguru Wetland. However, some sections of the data, particularly in Tables 1 and 2, could benefit from clearer formatting to improve readability. Adding footnotes to explain the abbreviations used in the tables would also enhance comprehension. 2. Methodology Explanation: While the research methods are generally well-explained, more details on how the sampling points were selected would improve the reader's understanding of the study design. Consider elaborating on the criteria used to choose the five points and the potential impact on the results. 3. Discussion Section: The discussion is well-rounded, but expanding on the implications of seasonal changes on bird species' migration and diversity, particularly in relation to conservation efforts, would strengthen the conclusions. Adding a few more recent references related to this topic could further support the argument. Once these minor revisions are addressed, the manuscript can be accepted for publication.
