Editor's Comment:

The said article is not well written and presented. To be fair with other papers that are well-written and to upkeep the excellent quality of this Journal, I have to deny acceptance for this paper in its present form. The authors are recommended to rewrite and resubmit a revised version of this article according to the following suggestions, prior to further review process:

- 1. Re-select another keyword for "knowledge test".
- 2. State the motivation and objective of conducting this study.
- 3. Have to mention where this study is conducted (with a geographic map).
- 4. Explain clearly how to conduct the survey. How to sample the information?
- 5. How to group data G1, G2, G5, G6? What happen to G3 and G4?
- 6. All equations must be numbered.
- 7. Have to unify the use of "%" and "percent" or "per cent".
- 8. In Table 2, what is the meaning of "level" at the last entry and at the last column?
- 9. In the same table, there is no "NC". Why include this footnote explanation?
- 10. Not all the references listed have been cited in the text. Why?
- 11. How to determine "low", "medium" and "high" level of knowledge?
- The conclusion is too brief. In fact, some sentences have not been supported by the study results.
- 13. The reference listing should be alphabetically arranged according to the last name of the first author. Besides, this listing must place the last name of the first author at the beginning. The format must conform to the requirements of the Journal.

A thorough proof-check (for spacing) and English-check is absolutely necessary.

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
