- The title approved for ethical clearance was "clinical and Radiological profile of stroke in Bisha, Saudi Arabia". However the Authors have proposed a manuscript for publication titled "Cerebral Venous sinus thrombosis (CVST) in adults- a case series of (5) five Patients from Bisha Saudi Arabia".
- The validity of the ethical clearance ends on 26/11/2020, And the authors have submitted the manuscript for publication on 10/11/2021. The authors have procured the ethical clearance on 26/11/2019, a month before reporting the first case of COVID-19 in China, thereby impossible to discuss on COVID-19 in the IEC meetings. The authors have also replied in the response to the previous comment That the ethical approval predates the advent of vaccination. This can Raise concerns regarding the ethical clearance of the study.

I suggest the Journal Editorial committee to take a call regarding the Ethical concerns of the manuscript, and I have no objections in the

Content of the manuscript proposed by the authors.
