Editor's Comment:

1. Incorrect use of abbreviations throughout the manuscript.

Use of abbreviation;

Words to be abbreviated should be written in full and abbreviations in a bracket when used for the first time and thereafter abbreviations should be used throughout the manuscript.

E.g., i. Complete Kawasaki diseases (cKD),

ii. Incomplete Kawasaki diseases (iKD).

Once written for the first time in the manuscript as above, authors should use CKD or IKD as may be applicable throughout the manuscript.

2. Intext References;

Numbers representing references in the reference section should be enclosed in square brackets. E.g., [9].

This should be consistent throughout the manuscript.

Accept for publication after effecting the above changes.
