DYNAMIC RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN VULNERABILITY TO CLIMATE CHANGE, LIVELIHOOD DIVERSIFICATION, PERCEPTION ON CLIMATE CHANGE AND INCOME OF THE FARMERS IN NORTH CENTRAL

The subject of the manuscript is of practical concern and the overall study protocol features adequate.

Reviewers' suggestions have been correctly accounted for and this manuscript well deserves being published in ARJA.

Yet, some small details should be still corrected by the authors:

- 1) title should be completed by north central Nigeria (the last word was lacking);
- 2) two little modifications in the beginning of the Abstract, underlines below in yellow:

"Aims: Although a number of researchers have outlined the strategies farmers adopt to ensure stability of family income yet, literature provides less understanding on the dynamic relationship between vulnerability to climate change, livelihood diversification, perception on climate change and income of the farmers. It is therefore the aim of this study to establish the relationship between these concepts.

Study design: Original research.

Place and Duration of Study: The study was conducted in North Central Nigeria in 2019.

Methodology: Multi-stage sampling technique was employed in the collection of primary data for this study. In the first stage, two (2) States were randomly selected from North Central Nigeria.
