

Editor's Comment:

I have now had a look at this submitted paper.

My recommendation is to reject it, as it does not contain enough empirical evidence to warrant publication.

In detail, it shows four tables of descriptive statistics on several variables in a data set, which does not admit any conclusion regarding the issue under investigation.

Generally, the manuscript is not well written, with many grammar flaws and incomplete sentences.

The first section "introduction" should explain the terminology used in the remainder of the paper.

Abbreviations such as 3PL should be defined at their first occurrence.

The section "literature review" does not contain a review of the literature.

Only three sources are reviewed, the remainder contains discussion.

The section "literature review" also contains some sentences that appear identically in the abstract.
