<p>All acronym names need to be defined when first appear, even in the abstract such as FYM, PPC.</p> <p>2. Some keywords duplicate the same as in the paper title. Other selections must be re-chosen. The name of the study site is an inappropriate choice of keyword.</p> <p>3. Please define the words, such as “Kharif”, “taluks” to the international readers.</p> <p>4. Metric unit must be used in scientific journal paper, not acre.</p> <p>5. Many English syntax errors have been detected. A thorough, careful proof-check and English-check is highly recommended.</p>	<p>1. All acronym names in manuscript have been defined in the revised manuscript.</p> <p>2. The keywords have been modified.</p> <p>3. The words which have common definition have been incorporated in the manuscript.</p> <p>4. The study was based on the primary information collected from the Karnataka farmers based on the landholding sizes which was in Acres only {Marginal & Small (less than 5 acre), Medium (5 to 10.0 Acre) and large farmers(More than 10 Acres)}. The respondent farmers gave the information regarding cost of cultivation of maize crop on per acre basis.</p> <p>5. A careful recheck has been done for the revised manuscript.</p>
