The article focused on Technological innovations on rice value chain actors in Cameroon, but the interpretation data of rice value chain actors in Cameroon is given and discussed shortly. I expect to give more related data for the same, to strengthen and more related analysis.	Thank you for this comment. This has been done. For example, we have provided more interpretation of why there is an adoption difference in mobile money transactions among the different actors, higher for retailers, compared to farmers. We have attributed this to limited market integration of farmers who receive farm inputs from the Rice Development Authority. Wholesalers and retailers on the other hand are more exposed to the effects of shortage of coins in Cameroon, and therefore are more likely to use mobile money transacations.
