Inconsistent statements. I thought the subject was the youngest (4<sup>th</sup> child), an 8-year-old boy. Please clarify the fact.</li><li>Additionally, the reference cited for the following statement, 'The 5th child who is 10yr old did not test positive in the serial PCR tests on day 1 &amp; 7' is unsuitable. What is the relevance of citing a reference (Klass &amp; Ratner 2021) for the statement? Please remove the reference or include relevant discussion for the reference.</li></ol></li><li>How was the child selected for the case study? The authors should have a set of inclusion requirements. Please state them in the case study.</li><li>Technical errors:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>Please proofread your manuscript: Article usage problems, spelling errors, incorrect preposition use, inconsistent spelling, and missing verb throughout the manuscripts.
