Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>Author claims that he has collected data from 50 respondents in the methodology section. Contingency tables have been constructed to test the hypothesis about the independence of attributes between sustainability and other socio economic factors of coastal resources utilization in Pangandran district.</p> <p>Tbale-1 categorizes fifty respondents into Low(5), Medium(24) and High (21) categories based on public perception.</p> <p>But from Tabe-2 to Table-4 , where cross-tabulation is under taken between economic, social and environmental factors with that of sustainability of coastal resources, the total sample size considerably vary from Table to Table.</p> <p>Sample size for Table-2 is 79, sample size for Table-3 is 67 and sample size for Tbale-4 is 114. This needs clarification from the author, whether the author has collected only from 50 respondents are sample size vary for each factor.</p> <p>Whenever the cell frequency is below 5, one need to be cautious in applying Chi-square test. In most of tables, cell frequencies is below 5.</p>	<p>The author has provided a more detailed explanation of the amount processed.</p> <p>The author took 50 respondents to be asked questions about economic, social and environmental factors. 2 questions about economic factors, 2 questions about social factors, and 5 questions about the environment. all information regarding anything including economic, social and environmental factors has been entered into the journal and marked so that there will be no misunderstanding. sorry in advance if there is a miss perception</p>
