Hello Doctor. Thank you for reviewing my article. I agree 100% that some sort of diagram(s) would make this easier to understand, and I wish that I could draw one. However, in my experience of treating (mostly stage 4) patients I have found that I have to approach the patient and treat them with how they present, what disease they present with and where the current issues are. Often my treatments involve dealing with side effects of previous treatments, or the disease process which have to be addressed before I can institute a comprehensive therapeutic protocol. Spinal cord compression, pulmonary effusions, inferior vena cava syndrome, bone marrow suppression with a platelet count of 10, and the like have to be dealt with first and then as the patient stabilizes and the data becomes available, I gradually institute an anti-cancer protocol as tolerated. I find that treatment is a dynamic process and not a linear one so I have been unable to create a useful diagram to represent this. I feel that it will take a better mind than mine to do so. Any thoughts would be greatly appreciated.</div> <div>2A.The Metabolic Approach section includes 182 references of which more than 50% refer to direct information of clinical data and trials.</div> <div>3A.
