| Minor REVISION comments | <p>Its stated as qualitative study but just a month time isn’t enough and data is quantitative.</p> <p>Initially mentioned 55 participants but its about 45 samples.</p> <p>Can u rectify highlighted part of result which was showing more than 100% in some section /Parts</p> | <p>-Qualitative study and data are quantitative: We did the thematic analysis for qualitative data in the study. We got the code from the thematic analysis, and then we manually did frequency for each code.</p> <p>-Also, we did not have many Bangladeshi family caregivers, and thus we could not do the quantitative analysis.</p> <p>-As ten caregivers out of 55 already participated in generating questions for the survey and participated in the pre-test survey, the rest 45 senior caregivers participated in the final interviews or surveys.</p> <p>-These are multiple responses, so it must be more than 100% when you add them. For example, one participant is asked about the sources of health information, and the participant mentioned television, newspaper, youtube, etc. When a participant has more answers, we need to do multiple analyses.</p> |
