The introduction was too focused on elaboration on the contraceptives which does not explain the need for the study.	There is need for literature to be relevant and specific. So relevant literature was used and we stressed the fact that there is scarcity of literature when it comes to the selected anthropometric parameters and use of hormonal contraceptives. So that's the essence of this work. i.e. to provide more literature.

The author can include the information on how many persons were involved in taking/rating the anthropometry measurement and the method to minimise the inter-rater variability.	Measurements were taken by three researchers to minimise inter-rater variability and digital instruments were used to avoid parallax error.
