Therefore, please consider my suggestions to develop your manuscript.</p> <p>Abstract Section: Consider numbering each aim rather than using commas.</p> <p>Please provide detail to your research design. What is the acronym MGM? Patients & Methods is not a category. What is the reason that Change is capitalized? Is this is the name of a program? Overall, the abstract needs a major revision.</p> <p>Introduction: Check the 800,000 number in the first statement. The commas are out of place. As a reviewer, this made be question the rest of the manuscript. This prompted me to research if the number was 8 million doctors or 800,000. Attention to detail is very important in research.</p> <p>As you revise the manuscript, consider that your readers are from around the world. Terms like “nationwide”, “MGM”, “Aurangabad” etc may need more description for the international audience of readers.</p> <p>Materials and Methods:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- “Cross-sectional” does not need to be capitalized.- Where is the questionnaire?- Binary Logistic Regression was mentioned, but this analysis was not reflected in the results section of the study (results/tables) <p>Results: This section could have a table which clearly shows demographics, results per question, etc.</p>	<p>Thank You.</p> <p>Corrected.</p> <p>Mahatma Gandhi Mission (Corrected) Corrected Corrected Corrected</p> <p>Corrected.
