In the material and method section, the authors present in detail the physiotherapy methods they applied to the patients included in the study. The presentation is well done both in the text and in the tables.</p> <p>The results are well presented both in the main text and in the tables. Follow-up at 3 and 6 weeks after the start of early recovery revealed that early mobilization after proximal tibial fracture has a positive influence on patients' recovery.</p> <p>The discussion section performs the analysis from the point of view compared to other reports, of the obtained results.</p> <p>Conclusions are in accordance with the results.</p>
