Compulsory REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) In the abstract you mention that Osgood Schlatter disease is a common cause of chronic anterior knee pain , then you extract only 8 cases over 1 yrs. Period (small sample size for a relatively common disease)2) In the methods you mention that the data were extracted from the patients `operation register, was there any patients underwent surgery? What kind of surgery and what was the indication ?3) What are the life style modifications offered to the patients? What was the long term follow-up results?4) No correlation with the patient`s height, weight, ethnic group or the kind of activity that the patients` practice (what type of sports)5) No radiologic figures (X-ray or ultrasound)	<p>Sounds contradicting. We have rephrased it.</p> <p>This is a retrospective study. None had surgery. We meant medical records. Not operation related to surgery</p> <p>Lifestyle modifications include: decreased physical activity and limit movements that aggravate pain, limiting activity based on symptoms, making use of ice for 20 minutes every 2-4 hours and after activity, wearing a knee pad during activity, cross-train with low impact sports such as cycling or swimming</p> <p>This study didn't perform any inferential statistics as the sample size was very low. It was not a usual condition.</p> <p>X-ray of knee is now attached</p>
