The sentence is reframed: Besides attempts to convert to normal sinus rhythm with drugs like flaicnamide or to control the heart rate with drugs like beta-blockers and calcium channel blockers, patients with AF also receive oral anticoagulation therapy to prevent future thromboembolic events 8 .</p> <p>Thanks.
