Thank you for your comment and the interest for our manuscript.  The patient was referred to cardiac surgery for surgical repair. However, the patient refused to undergo a second surgery after knowing the operative risks. She was put on an Angiotensin-converting enzyme (ACE) inhibitor and beta-blockers to limit cardiac remodeling and reduce the risk of pseudoaneurysm rupture. The patient was unfortunately lost of sight.
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	There is a need to describe treatment and outcome of this specific patient and add details of corrective surgery and or other treatments	We have added a paragraph on our manuscript where we explain that the patient didn't undergo surgery. Because operative risks of mortality she was put on medical treatment and was lost of sight.
