Ethnocentrism: tendency to apply one's own values and cultural elements to judge behavior. Cultural relativism: understanding that the beliefs, behaviors, ideas... of a given culture should not be judged by the standards of another. An important aspect that emerges from the reflection provided by this article is the issue of the legal challenges of cultural rights. The idea of the universality of human rights (and of their normative codes) is compatible with the existence of cultural differences. The key is to ensure equality and protect difference Equality in human rights demands guarantees against the cultural community itself when it imposes forms of life or cultural codes that are contrary to human dignity. Differences, on the other hand, must be recognized and respected even if they are contrary to the common convictions of the majority The article is of great validity and provides important knowledge to contribute to understanding and culture and allows organizing help and intervention with knowledge.
