<u>Compulsory</u> REVISION comments	<p>Thank you for the opportunity to review this paper.</p> <p>Overall the study is a good idea and a priority. But it needs more justification in the introduction, methods, and discussion.</p> <p>I really strongly recommend to the authors to please do a thorough proofreading of the whole paper. There are many instances of typographical errors, especially of words that are conflated and make no sense.</p> <p>ABSTRACT</p> <p>The sampling method should be modified.</p> <p>In the abstract section, the results must be separated from the conclusion.</p> <p>Introduction</p> <p>The introduction needs to be revised structurally.</p> <p>The contents of some paragraphs are repetitive.</p> <p>Have similar studies been conducted on the level of awareness of people about the toxic effects of cosmetics?</p> <p>In the last paragraph, it is better to refer to the gap in this field.</p> <p>Methods</p> <p>The sampling method needs to be reviewed and modified. What is the reason for choosing 12 students from 5 classes?</p> <p>It seems that according to the inclusion criteria, purposive sampling method has been used.</p> <p>Exclusion criteria must be Clarified.</p> <p>In the Methods section the Type of study is rather shortly described. Please provide details as to the general conduct of the study.</p> <p>What scale has been used to measure knowledge of chemical agents? Was this a standard scale? Did you use a validated scale? The level of knowledge has been measured? Please add this information.</p> <p>Please indicate exactly which analyses you have done in relation to each hypothesis.</p> <p>Please provide a good reason for using verbal consent.</p> <p>Results</p> <p>Merge Tables 1, 2, 3, 10, and 11 together.</p> <p>Merge Tables 4, 5, 7, and 8 together.</p> <p>Please avoid repeating the contents of the tables in the text.</p> <p>Discussion</p> <p>Please write a more concise discussion of the findings. Avoid mentioning unrelated content.</p> <p>Please add study limitations section.</p> <p>Conclusion</p> <p>Please add what you think is a strength of your research and what your results add to the current state of the research.What is the innovation of the present study?</p>	<p>All remarks made by the reviewers have been analysed and taken into account by the authors.</p> <p>These are: Structuring the problem; Stakeholder involvement; Indicator selection; Knowledge base assessment; Mapping and assessment of relevant uncertainties and Reporting on uncertainty information.</p> <p>Our sample was casual, taking into account the number of young people applying toxic cosmetics</p>
