For example, "PGR", "DAS". Not everyone necessarily knows what these are.</p> <p>The Results and Discussion can be shortened because the data are shown in the tables. Refer the reader to these tales in the text!</p> <p>Tables: The legends are incomplete. The name of the plant is not even mentioned. "SEm+" -- I am guessing this it the standard error for something but for what? What is "CD"? Tables need to be completely redesigned.</p>	Comment accepted and considered
