<b><u>Compulsory</u></b> REVISION comments	<p>The article entitled "Effects of Consumption of Campus Buka Diets on Some Health indicators of apparently Healthy Students of Abia State University Uturu" reported the consequences of student diet on blood counts.</p> <p>The results as expressed as mean value <math>\pm</math> SD demonstrated a major reduction in blood cell counts. The results should be presented as initial values and 3 months values in percentiles.</p> <p>To further try to understand the cause of cytopenia, the MCHC and the MCV of RBC should be reported. Iron deficiency or vitamin deficiency have different consequences on RBC parameters, whatever a combined deficiency may complicate the conclusion. It will be of interest to know if a part of the group has Hb congenital abnormalities.</p>	Thanks a lot for your contribution the needful has be done. However, in line with your opinion, remember we worked on apparently healthy students. Thus we are not concerned with possibility of complications or interferences from other health conditions.
