Every teenager experiences sex continuously or periodically, but this article feels that the teenager has had sex. Themes such as these are very appropriate for reference. References given are very few. The author should have made some additional references.	In reality, the study should cover many references. However, as it focused only on the life experience of first sex, we could not extend the scope. The other sub-topics are indeed reserved for later publications. This justifies a reduced number of references.
Minor REVISION comments	The author should change the title to make it more attractive. Writing the words of Dr Congo must be avoided in the headline of this paper.	Authors are open to any proposal for a title to be attributed to the manuscript.
Optional/General comments	Overall, this article provides essential knowledge to readers, especially adolescents, about the feelings of girls and boys before, during and after experiencing sexual intercourse.	The study focused primarily on the experiences of adolescent girls. It did not include boys. It would be much broader if it had included boys in their sexual experience
