Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>Basically, the article summarises the similarities and differences between MIS-C and KD. However, the title mentioned “ New relationship between KD and MIS-C”. There are no paragraphs/sentences to suggest this neither it is explored. So, suggest to change the title.</p> <p>Although both these entities are quite distinct, authors have mentioned epidemiological similarities in term of regional distribution and seasonal pattern. However as pandemic waves spread across the many countries all over the period years disturbing the regional and seasonal distribution. Suggest to refer the couple of systematic reviews of epidemiology of covid & KD. For example; systematic review by Zhang et al.(PMID: 34013488 ; Chen et al PMID: 33732254)</p> <p>There are many differences between KD and MIS-C, sufficient to diagnose except for couple of cases. So, it will be prudent to consider KD phenotype as one of the phenotype of MIS-C or COVID in children. Both the conditions could be consider as dysregulated/ exaggerated immune response to inflicting agent; infectious or non-infectious in genetically predisposed child.</p>	<p>Noted and revised</p> <p>Amended revision</p> <p>Corrected</p>
