Compulsory REVISION comments	The Author(s) does not aware on the intrinsic resistance of the studied antimicrobial resistance bacteria viz., <i>Escherichia coli</i> , <i>Klebsiella</i> spp., <i>Salmonella</i> spp., <i>Pseudomonas</i> spp., and <i>Vibrio</i> spp. Many of the reported results found that these strains are intrinsically resistance to many of the antibiotics. So it is not necessary to report it.	We would like to express our heartiest thanks to the reviewer for sharing the valuable opinion. We also think that the addition of the type of antibiotic resistance (intrinsic or acquired) of the selected bacteria would enrich the quality of information but we regret that we could not specify the type of resistance due to the lack of resources. We will definitely consider it as the future scope of our work. However, considering the valuable suggestions of the reviewer, we have tried to make some changes in our manuscript and reported that intrinsic resistance of bacteria can also be a reason of resistance to many antibiotics.
