<b>Optional/General</b> comments	<p>Sesame is a small-seeded crop lacking the emergence vigor of crops such as grain sorghum [<i>Sorghum bicolor</i> (L.) Moench] or cotton (<i>Gossypium hirsutum</i> L.) and requires a well-prepared seed bed with seeds placed in soil moisture . It is very susceptible to both drought and water-logging since it is slow in establishment. Since the seed of sesame is small, shallow planting is needed for successful establishment. With weak seedling vigor, limited competitive ability, and a lack of inexpensive and affordable labor, the use of preemergence (PRE) and/or postemergence (POST) herbicides are essential for commercial mechanized sesame production, especially in the U.
