<u>Compulsory</u> REVISION comments	In the article submitted for consideration, the authors demonstrated convincing understanding of the fact that the question of choosing a future specialization remains one of the most relevant in the field of research. In my opinion, objective results were obtained for the most preferred specialties were Internal medicine (37.9%), followed by surgery (35.5%), then family medicine (27%). While the field of anesthesiology was chosen by 14.5% of the participants. However, in answer to a separate question, 79.8% of respondents have not considered it as their future career.	- The two results are for two different questions the first result (14.5%) of the participants chose the field of anaesthesiology since they can choose it along with any other specialty. The second result (79.4%) of the participants stated that they would never consider anaesthesiology as their future career.
<u>Minor</u> REVISION comments	In addition, a significant positive of the study is the ability of the authors to operate with the received materials and correctly assess the practical side of the strategy of formation of future anesthesiologists. The importance of the profession of anesthesiologist now, in particular, is evidenced by the huge number of patients with Covid-19 in intensive care units.	It would be a great addition to the research but I do not know if it would be possible to write about since the research was done in 2019.
<u>Optional/General</u> comments	The study found that, unfortunately, anesthesiology is not a priority for students of King Abdulaziz University Hospital Jeddah.
