<u>Compulsory</u> REVISION comments	The weakest point of this manuscript is the study on etiology. The data presented in the study are mainly show association, not “cause and effect”. The author should be cautious when describing some variables as the causes of anaemia. Some variables are known causes of anaemia (such as iron deficiency; but some others like some forms of cancer	Thankyou for the comment. I have tried my best to assess the etiology on the basis of haemogram and it's correlation with peripheral blood smear findings. But for definitive cause and effect relationship we need ancillary investigations which were not feasible in all the cases owing to the large sample size and economic issues. Rest all revisions done.
