<u>Compulsory</u> REVISION comments	This MS has an interesting topic; however, it requires a major revision. In the Methodology, the exact place, time, inclusion/exclusion criteria of the study need to be provided in detail. Also, the terminology for serum lipid parameters, such as serum total cholesterol (TC), high-density lipoprotein cholesterol (HDL-C), serum triglycerides (TGs), low-density lipoprotein cholesterol (LDL-C), and very low-density lipoprotein cholesterol (VLDL-C) – should be used consistently in the article. The Discussion is written in a chaotic way, which needs to be clarified. Limitations of the study need to be added [e.g., a small study sample], and the Conclusion should be rephrased, to be clear and useful for clinicians.	Comment accepted and considered
<u>Minor</u> REVISION comments	In the whole text, rephrasing/editing for clarity/style is necessary [for example, different sentences should be corrected grammatically & abbreviations should be used properly in the abstract & in the text]. Also, a list of abbreviations should be done at the end.	Comment accepted and considered
