In the abstract, the word 'rural' appears thrice in the same line, you may rewrite it as 'This is the key source of crisis and distress in rural Telangana'.3. Same is the case with 'Therefore, rural people are facing the problems of poverty and exploitation which is impacting the rural economy'.4. What do you mean by- 'small and tribal hubs'5. Do you have any evidentiary support for- Nearly, two-thirds of the population lives in rural areas whose primary livelihood is farming?6. Kindly mention the source for: The major crops grown in Telangana are cotton, rice and maize which accounts for 85% of state's net cropped area.7. It mostly relies upon the production, consumption and marketing of agricultural commodities including livestock. Does it include only livestock and noting else?	
Minor REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Why was this period of 2009 and 2019 chosen? You may justify it as 5 years before becoming a new state and 5 years after becoming a new state.2. Last ten years in today's time would be 2012-22 and not 2009-2019, therefore kindly mention the time-period instead of writing last ten years.	
Optional/General comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. In your result and discussion part, Kindly use past tense as the research is already over and now you are explaining your findings. Kindly use was instead of is, had instead of has.2. There's no use of adding been-everywhere, kindly omit it from wherever it is unnecessarily used.3. There is a significant increase in household expenditure on education, health and liquor and social events by 55 to 65% during the period 2009 to 2019. But there is only one data, is it applicable to all the attributes?4. Kindly follow the suggestions in the commented manuscript
