<u>Compulsory</u> REVISION comments	The authors reported a case report of a patient 43-year-old who was admitted following an acute onset severe shortness of breath. After examination, the patient was tachypneic, tachycardic with clear lungs on auscultation. He had a S1Q3T3 pattern on his ECG with elevated d-dimer. Computed Tomography Pulmonary Angiogram revealed bilateral pulmonary embolism. There were no risk factors for VTE other than a mild SARS-CoV-2 infection 6 months back with persistent low grade systemic inflammation. Malignancy and thrombophilia screening was negative. The authors concluded that the possibility of the pro-coagulopathy state caused by SARS-CoV-2 virus infection for a prolonged period even following a mild clinical infection.
