Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>The authors have presented a case reporting with symptoms of sudden hearing loss and spinning sensation post a visit to a farm. The authors have observed ticks in the ear canal and tympanic membrane.</p> <p>The authors have stated involvement of vestibular nerve but have not mentioned administration of any vestibular tests to confirm it. What tests have author used to confirm vestibular nerve involvement? The manuscript in present form is purely speculative. Symptoms of spinning sensation and nausea may not necessarily be of vestibular origin.</p> <p>What could be the possible pathophysiology of sudden sensorineural hearing loss. Needs and explanation. Do the authors administer diagnostic tests to rule out middle ear involvement? Tympanometry? The middle ear reflex might give a good estimate of involvement of facial nerve? This needs to be elaborated in the present manuscript. If ticks are present in the ear canal and on the tympanic membrane, why did the patient not have any air-bone gap on audiometry.</p>
