You discuss the benign and malignant types of mucocele, but the impact on the postoperative course for the patients is missing, please add. You describe the mucocele as "Sago Pearl" like, another term used is myxoglobulosis, have you consider using this term and looking at this term in the literature? | |

References have not been formatted correctly according to author guidelines (example: "Hilly M, Adams ML, Nelson SC. A study of digit fusion in the mouse embryo. Clin Exp Allergy. 2002;32(4):489-98."), please correct. | |
