Such contributions adds up the value of the paper</p> <p>Presents an overall argument, but may not be fully developed or consistent in its application</p> <p>Lacks research topic or problem not clearly stated shown to be worth investigating</p> <p>Have a separate sub headings in literature reviewfor all the variables</p> <p>Literature review need detailed explanation and the gaps as well the theory to show the relationship between IVs and DV.
